MINUTES

- 1. Call to Order: 10:31 a.m. call to order.
- 2. Financial Report Tina Wilson, Chair: No updates
- ACM National Mary Van Sickle: Mary thanked everyone for the conference collaboration. She said that ACM National is growing in a very positive way, with strong leadership from Mike Wassenaar, a great management company and improved support for members.
 - A. New National Board Members: Shelley Wolfe of Philadelphia Public Schools, who is relaunching educational channels in Philly, and Gary Martin, the executive director in Sacramento.
 - B. 2016 National Conference in Boston, August 18-20 in the NE region. Mary said that this should be a great conference and encouraged all to register. There will be four tracks of conference topics, open houses, discussions of "best practices" and more. The early bird discount will end in May.
 - C. Grassroots Scholarships and GoFundMe: Selected fellows will receive free registration, plus \$500 as a travel stipend. If you know of someone who'd be a good candidate, spread the work the application is on-line on the ACM National Conference website.
 - The ACM National also started a GoFundMe account to afford to offer more of these in the future.
- 4. **Midwest Region Tina Wilson**: Tina said the 2017 National Conference will take place in Minneapolis. All ACM and nonmembers are welcome to attend.

Nominees will have one week to send a statement. The election officials will release the ballot following. Tina asked everyone to please vote.
